The Nova Scotian Institute of Science (NSIS), in collaboration with the Situating Science Knowledge Cluster (Halifax), is sponsoring the NSIS 2011 Science Writing and Video Competition. There are two categories of entries: one is the preparation of a written article; the other is on the production of a short video.

As the NSIS is soon to be celebrating its 150th Anniversary (in 2012), the 2011 Competition Committee is encouraging submissions that reflect on the history of science in Nova Scotia and the significance of this research and its application.

#### Prizes will be awarded in two categories:

## Science Writing: \$500 for the best article Science Video: \$500 for the best short video

The work of the winners will be featured on the NSIS and Situating Science Knowledge Cluster websites. The author of the winning paper will be invited to submit the paper for publication in the *Proceedings of the Nova Scotian Institute of Science*.

#### **Eligibility**

The competition is open to students currently enrolled in post secondary educational institutions in Nova Scotia.
